Wireless Internet Access

Norwegian Cruise Line offers wireless Internet access fleet wide, 24 hours a day. To help you get started, please refer to the useful information below.

How do I log in?

Once you are in range of the Wireless signal, simply connect to the broadcasted network. SSID (Network name):

NCL_Internet_Getaway

ogin:

- · Select New or Returning User icon.
- Enter Name, Stateroom Number, Date of Birth.
- <u>Password:</u> Enter password of your choice.
 Use this password for all future log-ins.
- Select a Pricing Option and get connected!

Guests with two last names may need to use both last names without spaces to login.
E.g. Jose Ramos Lopez → Jose (first name),
Ramoslopez (Last Name)

Ipod / Iphone / Ipad Users:

Disable "Auto login" as follows

- Settings > Wifi > NCL_Internet_Getaway>
 Tap on the blue arrow .
- . Turn off Autologin.
- · Reconnect to NCL_Internet_Getaway,
- Open Safari, enter any URL address in the address bar (for example: www.yahoo.com)
- . You will then be redirected to the Login Page.

Wireless access locations

Wireless service is available in all public areas and staterooms.

Don't forget to logout

To end your Internet session and discontinue billing, simply click on the "Log Out" button. If the "Log Out" button did not appear, simply type logout.com in your browser's address bar to immediately end your Internet session.

What is the cost?

3 pricing options are available:

Time Plan #1:

250 Minutes for \$100.00 (\$0.40/minute)

Time Plan 24

100 Minutes for \$55.00 (\$0.55/minute)

Pay-As-You-Go

\$0.75/minute

Time Plan minutes can be used until you disembark the ship. Time Plans are interchangeable between the Internet Café terminals and personal laptops.

A \$3.95 Activation Fee applies to all users upon your first login only. Printing is available at \$0.50 per document. Please see below for more information.

Laptops are available with the purchase of a Time Plan (limited quantity available).

SMTP Server and VPN Access

Microsoft Outlook and other mail client users may need to change the outgoing SMTP address to 172.31.0.2 VPN access is limited. PPTP and !PSec type VPNs may not connect.
